Join our daily hot lunch chef, **Cornelius Henry**, who will be offering a kitchen experience for our students in Grades 2-5 on Wednesday afternoons.

Cornelius will be conducting both culinary and baking instruction and experience to our students, experimenting with different recipes and teaching the correct way to measure, sift and fold.

Occasionally, students will be using peelers, but mostly all chopping and dicing will be completed by Cornelius prior to the beginning of class.

The cooking classes will take place in the Temple Emanu-El kitchen; therefore, parents need to understand that their children will be working carefully near ovens and stovetops.

Cornelius, a graduate of Johnson & Wales University, has taught food safety for more than 10 years.

He is also a chef with *Accounting for Taste Catering Service*, which includes community work with our JCDSRI students' hot lunch program and our senior citizens' Meals-on-Wheels program.

The fee for the 11-week program is \$121; there is also a \$15 ingredient fee per student for a total of \$136. Please make check payable to Cornelius Henry.

For safety reasons, the class is limited to the first 10 students who enroll in the program.
