The TikkunXDesign program at JCDSRI is supported by a prestigious Covenant Grant for Innovation in Jewish Education. We are one of the only elementary schools in the country that teaches design thinking to our students. Our focus is on mindsets that allow for productive and creative problem solving, while also taking on year-long projects that follow a Design Thinking process. We incorporate elements of Science, Technology, Engineering, Art and Math into our curriculum to help prepare our students for being responsible citizens in the 21st century.

- Continue to develop the capacity of the position into a liaison between JCDSRI and the RISD/Brown communities
